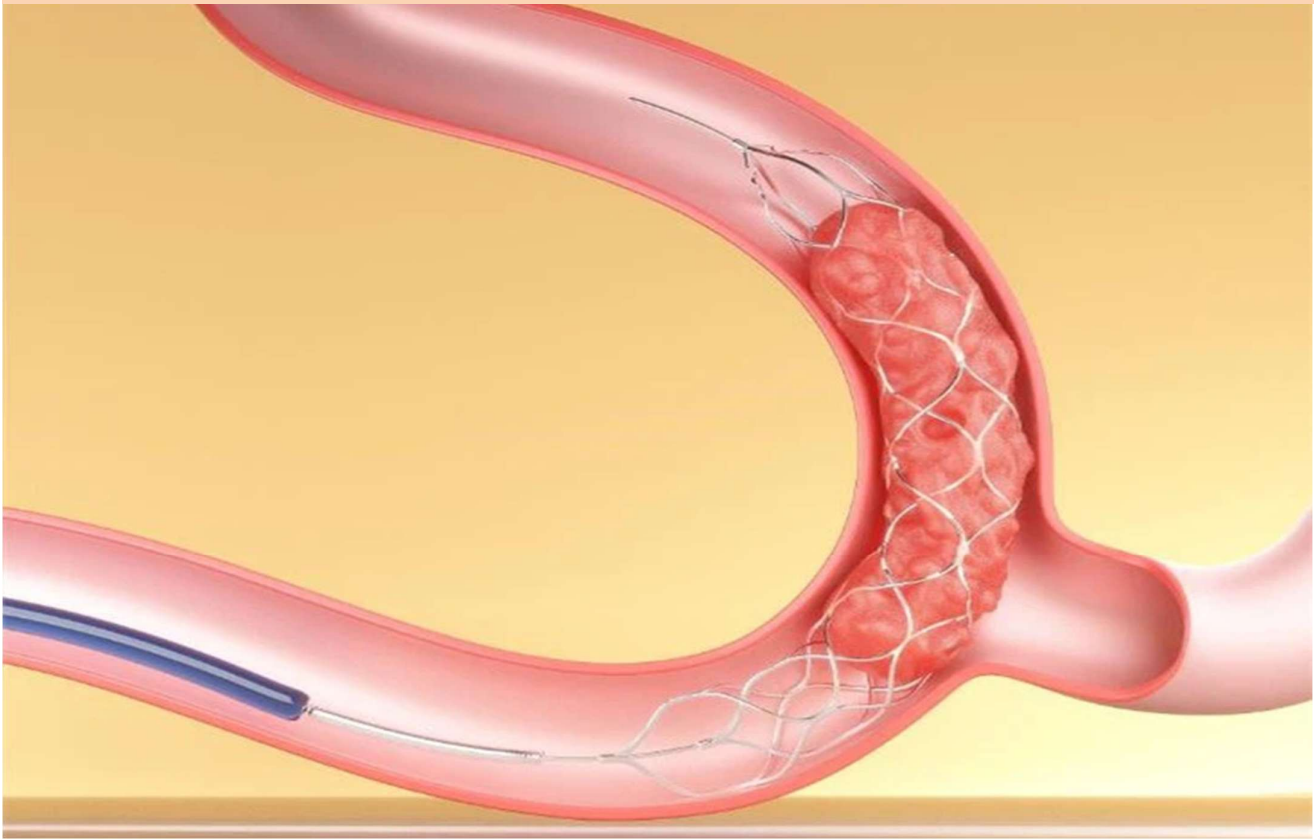

Endovascular stenting, which was virtually unknown about 30 years ago, has significantly advanced the treatment of aortic diseases. Today, patients with conditions such as aortic aneurysms (dilatation) or stenosis can be effectively treated through aortic stenting. This procedure has led to improvements in both life expectancy and quality of life. The technique is similar to stenting used in coronary arteries as well as in the upper and lower limbs.

Previously, open aortic surgery was the only treatment option, but it carried a high risk of mortality during the perioperative period. This minimally invasive approach has led to improvements in both life expectancy and quality of life.
